DESCRIPTION

Anderson Ranch and the RISD Career Center partner to share the costs of the residency program for up to two graduating RISD students who are selected for a Fall 2019 residency. This will generally cover the costs of the residency - \$1,500 - which includes housing, studio space, and meals.

Anderson Ranch's Artists-in-Residence Program fosters creative and intellectual growth for emerging and established visual artists. Residents have access to world-class facilities at the Ranch and 10 weeks of uninterrupted studio time. Anderson Ranch provides studios, facilities, a community of working artists, and feedback from visiting artists and critics. The Ranch setting is specifically crafted to aid artists in the production of their work, free from the distractions of everyday life.

ELIGIBILITY

- This opportunity is available to currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students who will graduate by June 2019.
- International students are eligible.
- You must first be selected by Anderson Ranch for the residency in order to be eligible for the funding.
- Residencies are offered to artists who work in one of the following media: ceramics, new media, photography, furniture design, woodworking, painting, drawing, printmaking, and sculpture.

APPLICATION PROCESS & COMPONENTS

- Apply to Anderson Ranch's Artist-In-Residence Program by their February 15 deadline and meet the criteria of their application process.
- In your application to Anderson Ranch, note your RISD education.
- Applicants are responsible for the \$30 Anderson Ranch application fee, travel to/from the Ranch, and the cost of their own materials.
- If you are selected by Anderson Ranch, they will notify the RISD Career Center and up to two RISD candidates will each receive \$750 of funding from Anderson Ranch and \$750 from the RISD Career Center to cover the costs of the program (\$1,500). If more than two RISD candidates are accepted by Anderson Ranch for these residencies, the Career Center will determine which two candidates will receive funding based on financial need.
